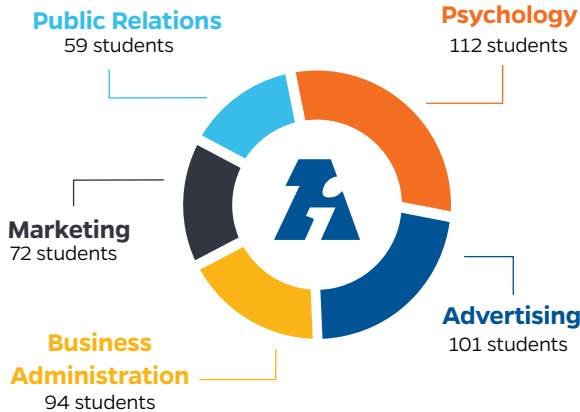

# INNOVATION MINOR

The UF Innovation Minor is exclusive to IA students. The Innovation Minor courses are designed to provide core knowledge base and a skill set to prepare IA students for the 21st century economy.



## CREATIVITY

Students examine the dynamics of creativity, discovery and innovation across disciplines. They learn problem-finding and problem-solving skills through design thinking.



## ENTREPRENEURSHIP

Students will develop a practical, hands-on understanding of the stages of the entrepreneurial process with a focus on the decision-making process within a start-up company.



## ETHICS

Students will become familiar with some of the major ethical theories, with ethical issues surrounding innovation, and with some of the psychological obstacles to acting ethically.
